CONTRIBUTE your own tools, models, lessons learned, and project results to strengthen collective knowledge and support reuse across the community.



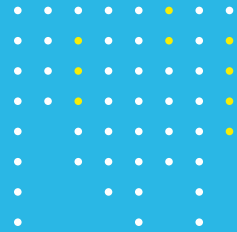
